BC Resident 2021/2022 CTHS – BC Broodmare Purchase Program

Program Requirements

- 1. This program provides to buyers of a broodmare in foal at any auction outside of British Columbia (except Alberta and Washington State) from November 1st, 2021, through March 31st, 2022, to receive 50% of the purchase price up to a maximum of \$10,000 for a purchase. For example, an eligible broodmare in foal that is bought for \$7,000 would receive a \$3,500 CDN incentive payment, whereas an eligible broodmare in foal that is bought for \$25,000 would receive a \$10,000 CDN (the maximum amount available incentive payment.
- 2. This program is open to BC Residents only.
- 3. For the purposes of this program, CDN\$ and US\$ are valued the same. (For example, \$10,000 CDN or US will generate a payment of \$5,000 CDN).
- 4. The monies will be paid when the purchaser makes a complete application to the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society -BC Division (CTHSBC) accompanied by a letter of commitment. The letter of commitment must state the owner intent to foal the mare in British Columbia and either sell the resulting foal in a sale conducted by the CTHSBC in 2023 or race the resulting foal in British Columbia as its owner.
- 5. Application must be made between February 1st & June 1, 2022
- 6. This program only applies to purchases made at public auctions outside of the province of British Columbia, excluding mares purchased in Alberta and Washington State.
- 7. Broodmares foaled in British Columbia are not eligible for this program.
