HASTINGS SHIP & WIN PROGRAM

THIS PROGRAM IS FOR NON-BC RESIDENTS ONLY

Hastings Racecourse is offering a Ship & Win Program for the 2022 live racing season.

Ship & Win will provide horse owners and/or trainers who bring non-BC horses to race at Hastings this summer a \$3,000 starter bonus for their initial outing along with an additional 35% purse bonus for all starts made in all claiming races

The purse bonuses extend to additional starts at the meet and are designed to enhance winnings when qualifiers win, place or show. Further, should a Ship & Win horse be claimed out of its first outing and subsequently run back at the meet, the original owner and trainer will receive all bonuses.

The simple rules for Ship & Win runners are as follows:

- Horses must have made their last start outside of British Columbia.
- 2. Horses cannot have raced in British Columbia in the past 24 months.
- 3. To qualify for this program, horses must be stabled at Hastings no later than Sunday, May 15, 2022, and must start no later than Sunday, June 12, 2022.
- 4. First-time starters are not eligible.
- 5. \$3,000 first-race starter fee to all qualifying horse(s) paid in the following manner:
 - Trainer of Record to receive \$1,000 when the horse arrives at Hastings.
 - The Owner of Record at the time of the horses first start to receive \$2,000
- 6. A 35% Purse Bonus for all Win, Place or Show finishers for all starts will be paid provided it is a claiming race. The 35% Purse Bonus will be paid 30% to the Owner and 5% to the Trainer.
- 7. If a qualified horse is acquired via claim after one start, the original owner and trainer continue to earn all Purse Bonuses on all subsequent 2022 Hastings claiming races'
- 8. Allowance & Stakes runners (including overnight stakes) are not eligible for the Purse Bonus; however, they will get the \$3,000 starter bonus (\$2,000/\$1,000 owner/trainer).

In September 2021, Hastings announced a major purse increase for the 2022 season. The track expects to average more than \$156,000 per day in purses. Hastings will begin its 45-day meet on May 7th and race through to October 16th.

Additional Rules and Information

1. Upon arrival all Trainers/Owners must deposit the horse(s) registration papers with the Race Office and sign and deliver an Application for Funds under this Program.

- 2. To quality the Applicant's horse must have raced in a minimum \$4,000 claiming race in all last three starts. If the horse has made less than 3 lifetime starts all starts must have been made in at least a \$4,000 claiming race.
- 3. All qualifying horse(s) must remain stabled and racing at Hastings until at least August 31, 2022.
- 4. If a qualified horse leaves Hastings stables before August 31st, 2022, the program registered owner and trainer must return all money paid out through this Program.
- 5. All qualifying horse(s) will have their registration papers retained by the Hastings Race office until August 31, 2022 and will not be released before that date.
